- Jason Ferrante, tenor and voice teacher who, in addition to maintaining a career as a stage artist, also makes a career as a voice teacher on many "Young Artists" programs including Wolf Trap Opera and the Minnesota Opera. Jason also leads the classical voice discipline for the National YoungArts Foundation.
