In its inaugural year, the fellowship will run from May of 2021 until May of 2022, and sponsor two singers on the island.

As part of the fellowship, the two singers selected will receive monthly professional consultations from the directors of the fellowship:

- Ana de Archuleta, founder and CEO of one of the opera world's leading agencies, ADA ARTISTS, who has mentored many of opera's most successful singers; and
- Jason Ferrante, tenor and voice teacher who, in addition to maintaining an active stage career, is voice teacher to several young artists programs (including Wolf Trap Opera and Minnesota Opera) and leads the classical voice discipline for National YoungArts Foundation.

In addition to the personal mentorship from the directors, the singers can look forward to performance opportunities facilitated by OIP, audition and feedback sessions with industry leaders, educational support and financial assistance with professional costs.

Olga also served as a voice professor and by the mid-1970's she had become the voice department head at CMPR.
